### THIS IS WHAT TO EXPECT IN 2020:

1. Safety and security will be upgraded and tightened with the introduction of turnstiles at the main entrance and the use of a biometric system for learners and parents to monitor and control access
2. The play area in front of the Grade R classes will receive a face-lift. Artificial grass will replace the natural grass and extra play equipment has been ordered for the Pre-Primary School to accommodate our increase in learner numbers
3. Our school is phasing in Grade 10 with a wide variety of subjects offered on FET level e.g. Engineering Graphics and Design, CAT, IT, Drama, Life Sciences, Physical Sciences, Hospitality Studies and the list goes on...
4. The Bistro @ Amberfield (The hospitality centre's restaurant) will open and will be fully functional as part of the subject of Hospitality Studies
5. An additional 15 staff members have been appointed to accommodate our growth in numbers
6. Amberfield College will manage the Aftercare Centre from next year onwards
7. Safety in the parking area will be improved with the introduction of scholar patrol, speed bumps and a zebra crossing
8. A second hand uniform shop will be opened
9. Computer Studies (ICT) will be implemented into the timetable from Grades 1-7 as a subject



10. E-Learning will be phased into Grade 9

11. D6 connect will be introduced as a two way communication platform between the school and the community

12. Two deputy principals have been appointed to assist the principals in the primary and high schools

13. A staff member, that has been part of Royal Schools for many years managing discipline in the schools, has been appointed and will be joining Amberfield College as Head of Discipline. Discipline will be his only and main focus.

We are looking forward to another exciting, prosperous and successful year at our prestigious school!
