



### Hello Parents and Guardians

It is a great privilege and honour to be part of the vibrant environment that is Amberfield College with its team of staff members and learners. Vulnerabilities allow us to seek answers and those are to be resilient – the ability to bounce back or "to spring back into shape."

Mental health or mental wellness is one of the biggest global challenges that adults and children are facing in the twenty-first century.
