



Staff News

Stationery

If you ordered stationery from Deans, most of the packs have been delivered. However, there are a few orders that are still outstanding.

Drop-off and Pick up

Once again we would like to remind you that only Grade 1 to Grade 4 learners are allowed to be dropped off and fetched at the Top Gate. Grade 5, 6 and 7 are to be dropped off and fetched at the Bottom Gate. Only learners in Grade 5, 6 and 7 with younger siblings will be allowed to exit at the top gate. Please comply with this rule as it will help alleviate the traffic.
