OUR SCHOOL

- The school is registered with the Gauteng Department of Education (Reg. 700401008) and Umalusi (Registration Number: 22SCH01 01000PA)
- Our code of conduct is aligned to a value system that include all religions and cultures
- We offer Gr RRR to Gr 10 IEB and Gr11-Gr12 NSC
- The language of tuition is English
- Other languages offered :

 - High School: English (HL); Isizulu (FAL); Sepedi (FAL); Afrikaans (FAL).
- Our educators are highly qualified and SACE registered
- Every classroom has a data projector, camera and is connected to Wi-Fi
- Maximum of 25 learners per Pre-Primary School class, 27 learners per Primary School class and 30 learners per High School class.

- Compulsory Subjects:
 - English (HL)
 - Afrikaans FAL or Sepedi FAL or isiZulu FAL (choose 1)
 - Mathematics or Mathematical Literacy (choose 1)
 - Life Orientation
- Three additional choice subjects must be selected: Accounting, Physical Science, Life Science, Information Technology (IT), CAT, Geography, History, Economics, Business Studies, Dramatic Arts, Engineering Graphics and Design (EGD)
- Consumer Studies, Hospitality Studies (optional subject offered based on interest in the subject.)

EDUCATIONAL MODEL

- Gr RRR - 10: IEB curriculum with our first Matrics writing the IEB exam in 2027
- Gr 11 & 12: CAPS curriculum (will be phased out by 2027)
- Remedial and intervention classes available at no extra cost
- Focus on IT, e-learning and STEM
- Sport and culture offered by external coaches for key sport codes and cultural activities.



Amberfield College offers an enhanced curriculum that prepares learners to write the IEB examination at the end of Grade 12, in line with legislation and Umalusi directives. While learners at Amberfield College still follow the CAPS curriculum, they are also equipped to handle the more rigorous questioning style of the IEB exams, which effectively prepares them for the academic demands of tertiary education institutions.
