1. POLICY STATEMENT

- The medium for instruction in all subjects, except for certain selected languages, is English
- Educators should speak English to learners except in classes for other languages (French, Sepedi, IsiZulu, Afrikaans)
- Learners should speak in English as far as possible. Learners may not speak to a teacher in a language that the educator does not understand
- Learners are free to use any language of their choice when communicating with each other

2. LANGUAGES

All learners attending a Regium School must take the following languages:

- Grade RRR – R English
- Grade 1 – 7 Home Language: English/Sepedi/Isizulu
 First Additional Language: English/Afrikaans
- Grade 8– 12 Learners may choose between the following languages:
 - Home Language: English/Sepedi/Isizulu
 - First Additional Languages: English/Afrikaans
- We also offer French as a Second Additional Language as a compulsory language in Grades 8 and 9 but a choice subject in Grades 10-12.

3. CURRICULUM

- Grade R – 3 follow the Foundation Phase curriculum
- Grade 4 – 6 follow Intermediate Phase curriculum
- Grade 7 – 9 follow the Senior Phase curriculum
- Grade 10 – 12 follow the FET Phase curriculum

4. ASSESSMENT

All grades are assessed in terms of:

- the National Curriculum Statement
- Assessment Guidelines for General Education and training
- CAPS
- Exams, tests, assignments must be written in English, except for language subjects
